Director's conversation with the Archdeacon, 27th July 1949.

On the 27th July last I had a conversation with Archdeacon MacMahon in my home at 25 St. Laurence Road, Clontarf, Dublin, where he was a guest at my daughter's wedding.

He confirmed that he had received Countess Markievicz into the Catholic Church, and that he would be prepared to give the Bureau a factual statement on this matter.

I said I would send a representative of the Bureau to him at his convenience, but we agreed to postpone action for the present as there was. no urgency.

The Archdeacon, however, died on 14th October 1949. There is consequently no statement from him on record.
